Tutankamun: Treasures of the Golden Pharaoh Tour

Thursday 28th November



We travel to London to meet our Blue Badge Tour Guide at the National Army Museum cafe in time to buy refreshments. Driving through Kensington & Chelsea we shall learn how the story of archaeology following Napoleon’s Egyptian Campaign led to the discovery of a boy king living 3,300 years ago, see where Howard Carter was born and died and hear how Tutankhamun and Ancient Egypt gripped public imagination from the Roaring Twenties onwards.

There will be free time for lunch on the King’s Road before we are transported to Ancient Egypt inside the Saatchi Gallery and accompany Tutankhamun on his journey to the afterlife. This dazzling exhibition celebrates the centenary of the tomb discovery. Many of the treasures have never left Egypt before and will not do so again, so this could be a once-in-a-lifetime chance to see them - 40 places are available for members.
